### SAINT ANTOINE RESIDENCE

Saint Antoine Residence, established in 1913, is a 260-bed skilled nursing facility located in North Smithfield, RI; it is the largest facility of its kind in the state. Saint Antoine provides long term care, short term rehabilitation Alzheimer's/dementia care, and a Hospice Suite for end-of-life care. The Residence employs close to 400 people and engages more than 150 volunteers. It is one of the largest employers in Northern Rhode Island. Saint Antoine has been a leader in eldercare, including the first Alzheimer's unit in the state, first Hospice Suite, and the first to use "primary care" in its provision of services. On its campus is a 76-apartment assisted living community, the VILLA at Saint Antoine. Saint Antoine is a founding member of CareLink, and an agency of the Diocese of Providence.

## Train...

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 16 years old and NOT a full-time high school student.
- Pass a BCI (Criminal Background Check).
- Pass a TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education) at a sixth grade level.
- Must be able to push or pull 70 lbs.
- RI state tax payments must be current.

If you qualify and are selected, you will enter into a 10 week training program that consists of:

Two weeks of Job Readiness Instruction  
Six weeks of CNA Training  
Two weeks of Clinical Training

Class hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 3:30 - 9:30 PM.

Upon successful completion of the CNA Training Program, you are eligible to take the Rhode Island Department of Health Licensure Test.

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AFTER GRADUATION

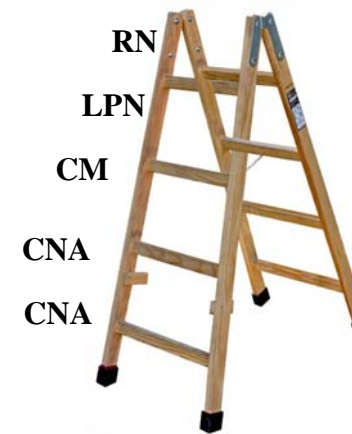
- Pass the Department of Health Licensure Test.
- Be willing to work as a CNA for at least 30 hours per week with benefits for one year.
- Be willing to be tracked by a Case Manager.
